- Firm-Fixed Price
 - Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ)
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Methods of Solicitation

- Invitation For Bid (IFB)
 - Request For Proposal (RFP)
 - Past Performance Trade-Off
 - Lowest Price Technically Acceptable
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Helpful Hints for Solicitations

- **READ EVERYTHING!**
 - Section J “List of Documents, Exhibits and Other Attachments”
 - Section K “Representations, Certifications and Other Statements of Offerors”
 - Section L “Instructions, Conditions and Notices to Bidders”
 - Section M “Evaluation Factors for Award”
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Helpful Hints for Solicitations (Cont'd)

- Bid Bond
 - 20% of the bid price or \$3M, whichever is less
- Davis-Bacon Act
- Acknowledge all amendments
- Timely
- Don't assume; if you don't understand, ASK!
