Snake River Water Pipeline


- Idaho awarded contract for pipeline; est completion 2025
- USACE awarded contract for Water Treatment Plant; est completion NLT Jan 2026


Geothermal Energy Project

 - AF plans to retire older "220" F-15E engines; affects one 366 FW squadron
